

Joint Polytechnic Admissions Exercise (JPAE) Quick Tips

1. Know the TP courses that you are eligible to apply

Applicants may apply for the diploma courses that are related to their course of study in ITE through JPAE, provided they have met the minimum GPA requirement of the courses that they are applying for.

2. How to compute Net GPA

Applicants who are active in their ITE's Co-curricular Activities (CCA) can gain up to 0.2 CCA bonus points. The CCA bonus points are used to compute the net GPA.

CCA Grade	CCA Bonus Points Awarded
A	0.20 point
B	0.15 point
C	0.10 point
E	0.05 point

$$\text{Net GPA} = \text{Final Cumulative GPA} + \text{CCA Bonus Point}$$

3. JPAE Application Process

Submission of Online Application

- 19 Feb 2024, 9am to 23 Feb 2024, 4pm (tentative)
- Check eligibility, relevant courses, minimum GPA requirement & Medical requirements on [TP website](#)
- Submit application via [JPAE portal](#)

System posting to a course is based on merit and subject to availability of vacancies



Release of Posting Results

Posting results will be released on 4 Apr 2024, 2pm (tentative) through [JPAE portal](#)



Acceptance & Enrolment to Posted TP Courses

- Successful JPAE applicants posted to TP will receive their e-enrolment packages via email
- Complete the acceptance & enrolment online via [TP website](#) by the stipulated deadline stated on the enrolment notice
- Upload Medical Report and other documents as stated in the e-enrolment package
